“INTERNATIONAL THEATRE PHENOMENON”, GUY MASTERSON, CREATES A NEW FOCUS FOR THE ADELAIDE FRINGE

Guy Masterson, described by the Australian in 2009 as an “international theatre phenomenon”, now an Adelaide institution after a string of hits over 6 festivals including *12 Angry Men*, *Under Milk Wood*, *Oleanna* and *Animal Farm*, has, this year, created an “international fringe within the fringe” as he puts it in the form of **The Centre for International Theatre at Higher Ground**.

Recognising that it is often difficult for discerning fringe audiences to find quality theatre in the melee that is the Fringe, Masterson has concentrated no less than eight proven international hits under one roof for the delectation of theatre loving Adelaidians!

In the first season of what is intended as an ambitious five year plan, Masterson has teamed up with Fringe Award winning venue Higher Ground to present 6 Australian premieres, all of which are multiple five star recipients at the Edinburgh Festival:

Austen’s Women – 14 of Austen’s heroines in 65 glorious minutes!

Scaramouche Jones – the international hit, written & performed by Justin Butcher. A magical odyssey of physical performance storytelling.

The Sociable Plover – starring Masterson himself, a darkly comic, mystery thriller set in a bird hide on the Suffolk Marshes.

Weights – a deeply moving, incredibly inspiring true story of a man’s recovery from being shot in a grim LA bar starring the victim himself.

The Event – a fiercely clever, deliriously witty dissection of the theatrical experience that makes one question ones own existence!

Bully – An immensely affecting tour-de-verse probing the generational link between the bully and the bullied.

PLUS, Masterson brings back his two Dylan Thomas favourites, Under Milk Wood and Fern Hill for only four special performances!
